Romaine E. Bell,

Born 1929 of Georgia, (age 20) became wife to Harry L. Thomas, Jr. son of Harry L. Thomas Sr (of Richmond, Virginia), married July 11, 1953, as published in the Baltimore Afri-American newspaper. She was the daughter of Edmind L. Bell and Mamie Bell. Ms. Bell lived at 1262 Neal Street NE, April 1, 1950. Her brother was Eldrey L. Bell Bell, Romaine E., 1950 Census Record, April 1, 1950, block No. 60, Enumeration district 1-701, Series T628, family 903, page 9A

At the Neal Street address were family members Edmind (age 40), Mamie (age 38), Romaine (age 20), Eldrey L (age 19) all recorded as “Negro” and of Georgia, and Cousin Rica Brown a female (age 23) of D.C. Official census enumeration schedules recorded them as being “Negro”. The indication of race, assigned, or perceived was on the enumeration schedules common.

She also served as a president of the Woodridge Civic Association
